*In addition to our established workshops, we can custom design classes and events based on unique community needs and desires.*

**Rhythms & Rhymes - Interactive Music Making for Young Children** From familiar songs and dances to circle games and silly songs and stories, the goal is to be creative and musical, but the focus is on fun!

**Creative Musical Expression for Families** Parents and children move, play and sing together. Experience the joy of rhythm, melody and harmony. No musical experience necessary.

**Make-Your-Own-Song** Kids learn to write melodies, using words and rhythm from their own stories. Improvisation, rhythm, interactive fun!

**Rhythm Healing Percussion** Play 'Speak Beats' on hand drums and percussion instruments from all over the world. Instruction in basic rhythm playing and techniques, with multi-media presentations.

**Brazilian Percussion** Play rhythms from Bahia including samba and Afoxé, using traditional Brazilian instruments. And learn to dance the samba!

**Jazz Ensemble** Basic rhythmic and melodic improvisation, blues, and expression. Beginning jazz theory, improvisation, song forms, and trading 'call and response'.

**Singing** A workshop for those who love to sing. Play with melody, rhythm, harmony, vocal improvisation, find your personal style.

**Songwriting** Self-expression through lyrics and melody. Learn about song structure, principles of lyric writing, analyze new and old hit songs, develop listening skills.

**Music Technology** How do you record a voice? A guitar? Synth? Learn your way around a recording studio, even record a song from start to finish!

**Video** The art and technology of making documentaries, narratives, music videos. Hands-on experience with camera operation, sound production, editing and directing.

**Art** Watercolours, print-making, murals, mask-making, paper sculpture and more!

**Jewelry Design** Design and make earrings, necklaces, bracelets, using beading, metalwork and other techniques

**Individual Lessons** In piano, guitar, voice, saxophone, drums.
